


WHEN TRYING TO RETURN HOME By Jennifer Maritza McCauley

A short story collection addressing issues of race, class, and gender, the invisibility of marginalized women, and the uneven distribution of resources for people of color.

Profoundly moving and powerful, this collection digs deep into the question of belonging. In "Torsion," a young woman is torn between the overwhelming love she has for her mother and the need to break away. "La Espera," is the story of a man, his wife, and his mistress, and investigates the thin lines separating love and hate, obligation and longing. And in "Last Saints," a woman in 1930s Louisiana searches for someplace to call her own when home is no longer an option.

All of McCauley's stories feature Black American and Black Latinx characters who wrestle with their ties to a time period, a place, or intracultural expectations, and who yearn for "homes" in many kinds of idealized spaces. McCauley's work will appeal to fans of Deesha Philyaw's THE SECRET LIVES OF CHURCH LADIES and Rion Amilcar Scott's THE WORLD DOESN'T REQUIRE YOU.

A version of this collection was a finalist for the Prairie Schooner Book Prize, and many of the individual stories have been nominated for the Pushcart Prize.


IN THE MIDDLE OF HICKORY LANE By Heather Webber
